

This school district shall have a superintendent of schools, selected in the manner provided by law. No person shall be eligible to the office of superintendent of schools unless such person shall hold a valid administrator's license issued by the State Department of Education and shall have had not less than six (6) years which shall include at least three (3) years of administrative experience as a school building principal

- a. in a school with an "A" or "B" accountability rating, or
- b. in a school that increased its accountability rating by a letter grade during the period in which the principal was employed as principal at the school, or
- c. in a school with comparable accountability rating or improvement in another state which shall be verified by the Mississippi Department of Education

These provisions of the Mississippi Code of 1972 Section 37-9-13 shall be applicable to any superintendent of schools selected on or after July 1, 2017, who has not previously served as a superintendent or assistant superintendent within the last five (5) years.
