Lots of fun is had after school discovering, exploring, and learning on Discovery Street. Homework support is also provided to students who attend the Discovery Street after school program.

Enrollment opens February 11th, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. on a first-come, first-serve basis. Enrollment is limited. First priority is given to children currently enrolled in the Discovery Street program. The program is offered to all grades Pre-K-5 in the Starkville Oktibbeha School District. Children must be fully potty-trained in order to participate in the summer program. If your child needs or requires services that we cannot sufficiently provide, families will be responsible for finding alternate care provisions.
