

Discover a whole new level of excellence on Discovery Street, our fee-based, summer childcare program for children enrolled in grades PreK-5. Lots of fun is had during the summer discovering, exploring, and learning on Discovery Street.

Enrollment opens February 11th, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. on a first-come, first-serve basis. Enrollment is limited. First priority is given to children currently enrolled in the Discovery Street program. The program is offered to all grades Pre-K-5 in the Starkville Oktibbeha School District. Children must be fully potty-trained in order to participate in the summer program. If your child needs or requires services that we cannot sufficiently provide, families will be responsible for finding alternate care provisions.

Program Dates: June 6, 2022- July 15, 2022 (Program is closed on July 4th)

Time: 7:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, & snack provided

Location: Sudduth Elementary School

Transportation: Parents will drop-off and pick- up students at Sudduth Elementary. Students will be bussed to Henderson Ward Stewart Elementary for breakfast and lunch. Students will need to be at Sudduth by 8:15 each morning to be bussed over to Henderson Ward Stewart Elementary.

Registration: \$50 (Non-Refundable)

Cost: \$1200; first payment of \$600 is due May 1; second payment of \$600 is due June 1; \$100 discount for multiple children
